



## **DEFINITION OF THE BOWLING HALL OF FAME GENESEE COUNTY, STATE OF MICHIGAN**

The Bowling Hall of Fame for Genesee County is designed to provide a lasting honor and recognition for those persons, living or dead, who have contributed to the game of bowling through ability or dedicated service.

Candidates may be area bowlers, proprietors, and bowling association executives. They shall have individually performed through bowling ability, promotions, or other contributions for 10 or more years and be at least 50 years of age, or the above qualifications for 30 years, whichever comes first.

Plaques for each honoree will be displayed at the Flint Bowling Association office until such time as a Hall of Fame room is established. Each honoree will be given a permanent award symbolic of the Hall of Fame selection.

The Hall will have annual inductees and anyone can be nominated. Of the numerous nominations received, those not selected will remain on file for future consideration for selection into the Hall of Fame. All selections are made on the basis of character, sportsmanship, personality, leadership, dedication, bowling ability and achievements.
